Motion by Andrew Kolstee to **waive reading and approve the minutes of January 31, 2022 Meeting of the Elections Oversight Committee** was seconded by Arthur Sintef and passed by voice vote.

Appointing a Collector was discussed along with the manner in which they shall perform the duties.

Furthermore, the link to the Google Drive folder would be accessible to the public and linked on the State Committee Elections portal on the LPNY website. There were no objections to this process.

Arthur Sintef suggested that Alan Bombria of Suffolk County may be interested in the position of Collector.

William Cody Anderson indicated that he would work on creating objections templates and outlining the process. Furthermore, he indicated that we would need procedures for hearings.
